HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1114, L.D. 1332, Bill,
"AN ACT Providing for Student and Faculty Members of the Board
of Trustees of the University of Maine."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and
inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT Providing for
Student, Classified Employee and Faculty Members of the Board
of Trustees of the University of Maine.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all
of the first paragraph after the amending clause and inserting
in its place the following:

'Sec. 4. Board of trustees. The board of trustees of the
university shall consist of 18 persons.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"Sec. 4." in subsection 3 by striking out all of the first
underlined sentence and inserting in its place the following:

'One of the 18 members shall be a faculty member from the
university having the rank of instructor or a higher rank.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"Sec. 4." by adding at the end the following:

'5. Classified employee member. One of the 18 members shall
be a full-time classified employee of the University of Maine.
The classified employee member shall be a full voting member
of the board of trustees. This member shall serve for a term
of 2 years and until his successor is appointed. The classified

employee member shall be eligible for reappointment, but he shall not be eligible to continue to serve as a member if he ceases being a full-time classified employee of the University of Maine. The classified employee member shall be appointed by the Governor within 30 days after a list of 3 eligible members has been submitted to him by the designated system-wide representative body representing classified employees of the university. If one or more classified employee bargaining units, as defined in Title 26, section 1024, subsection 1, paragraphs C through F, is established and certified by the Maine Labor Relations Board, then the bargaining agent representing unit having the greatest number of classified employees of the university shall submit the list of 3 eligible members to the Governor.'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out all of the last paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'The faculty member, classified employee member and the student member shall be nominated for 2-year terms by the Governor within 60 days after the effective date of this Act.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for a classified employee member on the University of Maine Board of Trustees.
