AN ACT to Permit the Taking of Togue from Sebago Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2651, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 5, is further amended by adding after the 3rd paragraph the following new paragraph:

Any rule or regulation promulgated by the commissioner establishing a daily limit on the taking of togue on Sebago Lake in Cumberland County shall provide a daily limit of not less than 2 togue in any one day.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would establish a minimum 2 togue daily limit for ice fishing on Sebago Lake.
