AN ACT to Repeal Certain Laws Relating to Public Safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 25 MRSA § 2431 is repealed.

Sec. 2. 25 MRSA § 2432, as amended by PL 1971, c. 592, § 35, is repealed.

Sec. 3. 25 MRSA § 2433 is repealed.

Sec. 4. 25 MRSA § 2436 is repealed.

Sec. 5. 25 MRSA § 2436-A, as enacted by PL 1965, c. 365, § 5, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals certain statutes relating to public safety which are no longer needed, including provisions restricting certain occupations in maritime towns, removal or repair of defective chimneys, stoves and boilers and restrictions.
