COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1124, L.D. 1342, Bill, "AN ACT to Require an Annual Adjustment in the Standards of Need for Families Receiving Aid to Dependent Children."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'RESOLVE, to Require the Department of Human Services to Provide the Legislature with Information Relating to the Determination of Need under the Aid to Families with Dependent Children Program.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Department to provide information. Resolved: That, for each year from 1969 to 1976, the Department of Human Services shall determine the cost and number of new cases under the Aid to Families with Dependent Children Program which would have resulted if the Department had used the same level of payments, but had also used the current year's standard of need based on cost-of-living statistics of the United States Department of Labor; and be it further

Resolved: That the pepartment shall study alternatives for funding the costs of using a more recent standard of need

figure for determining benefits under the Aid to Families with Dependent Children Program; and be it further

Resolved: That the pepartment shall determine the impact on the state budget of funding the Aid to Families with Dependent Children Program at 100% of the current year's standard of need during fiscal year 1978-79; and be it further

Resolved: That the Department shall provide all of this information to the Joint Standing Committee on Human Resources by January 15, 1978.
