STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Prohibit the Washing of Domestic Animals in Segabo Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P&SL 1913, c. 157, § 2, 1st sentence, as last amended by P&SL 1975, c. 132, § 1, is further amended to read:

No person shall bathe in the waters of Sebago Lake within 2 miles of the intakes of the Portland Water District, nor shall any person wash linen or other articles of personal apparel or domestic animals in the waters of said lake.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prohibits the washing of domestic animals in Sebago Lake in order to protect the purity of the lake's waters, which are used in municipal water supplies and for the water supplies of cottages bordering the lake.
