SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1128,
L.D. 1345, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Membership and the Legis-
lative Mandate of the Capitol Planning Commission."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of subsection 4 and
inserting in its place the following:

'4. Resident. One resident of the City of Augusta to be
appointed by the Governor for a term of 2 years. This member shall
be in addition to the member from the City of Augusta set
out in subsection 3; and'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that there
will be at least 2 residents of the City of Augusta on the Capitol
Planning Commission at all times, one of whom will be a council-
man.
