SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1128, L.D. 1345, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Membership and the Legislative Mandate of the Capitol Planning Commission."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of subsection 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'4. Resident. One resident of the City of Augusta to be appointed by the Governor for a term of 2 years. This member shall be in addition to the member from the City of Augusta set out in subsection 3; and'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that there will be at least 2 residents of the City of Augusta on the Capitol Planning Commission at all times, one of whom will be a councilman.
