AN ACT Relating to Expenditures of the Town Road Improvement Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

23 MRSA § 1705, first sentence, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 149, is further amended to read:

The expenditures of this fund shall not exceed the sum of ~~\$15,000~~ \$18,000 in any one mile.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this legislation is to increase the expenditure limitation on town road improvement projects. Inflation has caused the cost of construction to increase significantly and the \$15,000 limitation does not permit adequate improvements.
