STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, to Abolish the Augusta State Airport.

Director of Bureau of Public Improvements authorized to convey property.

Resolve: That the Director of the Bureau of Public Improvements is authorized to grant and convey to the City of Augusta the interest of the State in any and all property whether real or personal held by the Augusta State Airport, not to include any land and buildings under the jurisdiction of the Adjutant General. These conveyances shall be on such terms and conditions as the director shall decide, subject to the approval of the Governor.

If the City of Augusta shall refuse to purchase the property set forth above, the Director of the Bureau of Public Improvements is authorized and directed to convey by sale, by sealed bid delivered by certified or registered mail, the interest of the State in that property, provided:

1. **Notice.** That notice of such sale be published 3 times, once each week in a newspaper with statewide circulation; and
2. **Bids.** That the director shall have the right to accept and reject all bids.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve would authorize the Director of the Bureau of Public Improvements to sell or convey the property of the Augusta State Airport to either the City of Augusta or to the highest bidder, if Augusta refuses to purchase the property. The intent of this bill is to save the State of Maine operating costs at the Augusta State Airport.
