SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 396,
for Sales
L.D. 1355, Bill, "AN ACT Regarding the Sales Tax/Made Through
Vending Machines."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last line
of the first paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'Until December 31, 1980, the term'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of the
3rd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'Until December 31, 1980, "food products"'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of the
last 2 lines before the statement of fact and inserting in their
place the following:


'Until December 31, 1980, this exemption shall apply to all vending
machine sales regardless of price;'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the vending machine sales tax
will be effective from the time the bill becomes effective until
December 31, 1980.
