AN ACT Establishing Standards for Surveys of Municipal or County
Boundaries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 2001, sub-§ 7 is enacted to read:

7. Surveys of municipal or county boundaries. The survey of any municipal or county boundary within the State shall be conducted under the direct supervision of a land surveyor registered in the State. The survey shall be conducted to meet the standard of accuracy of a Class "A" survey as adopted by the Maine Society of Land Surveyors. A copy of the standards of survey shall be on file in each registry of deeds within the State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would require that a survey of any municipal or county boundary shall be supervised by a registered land surveyor and shall meet the standards of a Class "A" survey. A copy of the standards for surveys will be on file in each registry of deeds.
