HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1225, L.D. 1359, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide County Commissioner<sup>s</sup> Districts in Washington County."

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§105-H." in the 3rd paragraph, 5th line (last line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "and Marion Edmonds" and inserting in their place the following: 'and Marion, Edmonds'

Further amend the bill in section/<sup>1</sup>in that part designated "§105-H." in the 5th paragraph by striking out the last 2 underlined words "that district" and inserting in their place the following: 'the county'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Transition. The transition of the Washington County district system shall be made in the following manner: In 1978 a commissioner resident of Commissioner District number 3 shall be elected. In 1980, a commissioner resident of Commissioner District number 2 shall be elected. In 1980, a commissioner resident of Commissioner District number 1 shall be elected. Thereafter, elections shall continue in a manner so that each district shall at all times have a commissioner elected from that district on the board.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide county-wide voting in the county commissioner elections.
