
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
1151, L.D. 1369, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Safeguards Against the
Use of Discriminate and Exclusionary Zoning Practices."

Amend the amendment in that part designated "§2157." in
the first paragraph by inserting before the last underlined
sentence the following underlined sentence:

'A municipality may exclude manufactured homes, or require them
to be located only in parks, in some, but not all, parts of the
municipality.'
