COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1113, L.D. 1372, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Dissolve Vocational Region 9 and to Establish a  
Vocational Center to Serve Northern Oxford County."

Amend the bill in section 3 by striking out all of the  
last sentence of the last paragraph and inserting in its place  
the following:

'The result of the vote shall be declared by the cooperative  
board and a certificate of the result of the vote of each  
school unit shall be filed with the commissioner of Educational  
and Cultural Services. A vocational center shall be established  
within the town of Rumford providing that a majority of the  
6 administrative units of the vocational region of which one  
is Rumford, vote affirmatively on the article in the preceding  
paragraph.'

Further amend the bill in the emergency clause in the  
2nd line (1st in L.D.) by inserting after the word and punctuation  
"preamble," the following:

'except for section 3 of this Act which shall become effective  
immediately, all remaining provisions of'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for an immediate effective date only for the purpose of submitting the question to the voters of Vocational Region 9, and to make it clear that the results of the vote of each school unit in the region shall be certified to the commissioner.
