**AN ACT to Prohibit Preference Given to State Employees in Civil Service
Positions.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA § 672-A is enacted to read:

§ 672-A. State employee preference in state hiring for classified positions
prohibited

The Commissioner of Personnel shall promulgate regulations to ensure that
there is no preference given to persons employed by the State in filling a
position in the classified service of the State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prohibits any preference to state employees in hiring for a classi-
fied state position.
