AN ACT to Prohibit Otter Trawling for Scallops in the Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 4406 is enacted to read:

§ 4406. Dragging scallops by otter trawl; Penobscot River

It is unlawful to fish for or take scallops by use of an otter trawl inside and up-river of a line drawn from the lighthouse on Dice Head, Castine, to Turtle Head on Islesboro and thence to the town wharf at Bayside, Northport.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit otter trawling for scallops in the Penobscot River.
