STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Prohibiting Financial Institutions from Making Mortgage Loans
Subject to Payment on Demand.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

9-B MRSA § 468 is enacted to read:

§ 468. Mortgage subject to demand

Notwithstanding any provision of this Title, no financial institution shall make any mortgage loan which is subject to payment on demand.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would prohibit financial institutions from making mortgage loans which are payable on demand.
