HOUSE AMENDMENT A"to H.P. 1236, L.D. 1389, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Administration of Medication."

Amend the bill by striking out in section 10 all of the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 10. 32 MRSA §2102, sub-§2, ¶F, as repealed and replaced by PL 1977, c. 395, §1, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentence.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment is presented on behalf of the House Committee
Bills in the Second Reading to clear up potential conflicts
between this bill and public law 1977, chapter 395, section 1. It
is essential that this amendment be adopted to prevent conflicts
from being enacted in the statutes.
