SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1144, L. D. 1391, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Provide a Uniform Basis for Recognizing the Right of  
the University of Maine Employees, Maine Maritime Academy Employees,  
Vocational-Technical Institute Employees and State Schools for  
Practical Nursing Employees to Join Labor Organizations."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in subsection 1-C by inserting  
at the end after the punctuation the following: 'The State  
Board of Education shall utilize the Office of State Employee  
Relations for the purposes of this chapter.'

Further  
Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the statement  
of fact the following:

'Sec. 17. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the  
General Fund to the Executive Department, Office of State Employee  
Relations, the sum of \$29,000 for the fiscal years 1977-78 and  
← 1978-79 to carry out the purposes of this Act.  
The breakdown shall be as follows:
