AN ACT Increasing the Fee for Motor Vehicle Inspection to \$3.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA § 2122, 3rd ¶, last sentence, as amended by PL 1973, c. 291, § 2, is further amended to read:

The ~~\$2~~ \$3 fee as required by law for semiannual inspection shall not apply in such case.

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA § 2125, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 291, § 4, is further amended to read:

§ 2125. Fees

The operator of any official inspection station, or his agent, shall conduct the inspection of motor vehicles presented to him for that purpose in accordance with section 2122 and with the rules and regulations promulgated by the Chief of the State Police, for which he shall receive a fee of ~~\$2~~ \$3 for each vehicle inspected, this sum not to include labor or material used in correction of faults in equipment.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases the biennial fee for a motor vehicle inspection to \$3.
