COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1173, L.D. 1403, Bill, "AN
ACT to Increase the Minimum Wage to \$3 per Hour."

Amend the bill by striking out in the 6th line^(5th line in L.D.) after the
amending clause the following: "\$3" and inserting in its place
the following: '\$2.75'

Further amend the bill in the last line by striking out the
following:

~~"7-but-in-no-case-shall-the-minimum-wage-exceed-\$3-per-hour"~~
and inserting in its place the following:

', but in no case shall the minimum wage exceed \$3 \$4 per
hour'

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to:

1. ~~R~~aise the minimum wage to \$2.75 per hour; and
2. Raise the maximum minimum wage from \$3 to \$4 per hour.
