AN ACT Relating to Military Service Credits Under the Maine State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA § 1094, sub-§ 13, 2nd sentence, as amended by PL 1969, c. 449, is further amended to read:

A state employee shall be entitled to this credit only if at point of retirement he shall have at least ~~15~~ 10 years of creditable service in the State Retirement System.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit state employees to qualify for military service credit upon completion of 10 years of creditable service in the Maine State Retirement System, rather than 15 years of service as the law presently provides. Although it would be impossible to predict with any degree of accuracy the cost of this change, it is believed that such cost would be minimal.
