HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
1162, L. D. 1420, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for the Registration
and Regulation of Off-road Vehicles."

Amend the Amendment in section 1 in that part designated
"§482." by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting in
its place the following:

'2. Off-road vehicle. "Off-road vehicle" means vehicle
designated or intended for off-road use on land, water, snow,
ice, marsh or other natural terrain. Off-road vehicles shall
include but are not limited to all terrain vehicles, 4-wheel
drive vehicles, dune buggies, automobiles not licensed for
road use and other motor driven recreational vehicles. Off-
road vehicles shall not include a motor boat, golf cart, aircraft,
motorcycles, trailbikes, minibikes, snowmobiles, ^{nor a} farm, industrial
or forest harvest vehicle such as a skidder, construction
equipment, home power utility vehicle, vehicles used only in
scheduled racing events, or other off-road vehicles not
generally used for outdoor recreation.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to exclude motorcycles,
trailbikes and minibikes from the provisions of the bill.
