IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT to Provide for a Sign on Route 302 at the Maine - New Hampshire Border Indicating the Scenic Route to Old Orchard Beach and the Lakes Region.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

23 MRSA § 1203, sub-§1 is enacted to read:

1. Specific signs. The department shall maintain a sign at each of the following locations:

A. On Route 302 within 100 yards of the Maine - New Hampshire border. The sign shall bear the legend: Old Orchard Beach — Lakes Region — via scenic route 302 — Welcome — Bienvenue.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for a sign at the Maine - New Hampshire border on Route 302 to indicate the scenic route to Old Orchard Beach and the Lakes Region. This sign will encourage tourist traffic to use Route 302 and will help the local economy along Route 302.
