HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1202, L.D. 1431, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Granting Administration of an Intestate's Goods or Estate under the Law of Decedent's Estates."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§1551." in the 4th line (same in L.D.) by striking out the word "and punctuation" and inserting in its place the following: 'husband,'
