HOUSE AMENDMENT" To COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A" to H.P. 1200, L.D. 1441, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Required Voting on Certain Boards and Commissions with Quasi-judicial Authority."

Amend the amendment by inserting before the first paragraph the following:

'Amend the bill _______ in that part designated "§421."
subsection 1, by striking out at the beginning of the first sentence,
the underlined word "Every" and inserting in its place the following: 'Except as otherwise provided by statute, every'

Further amend the amendment by striking out at the beginning of the first line of the first paragraph the following word: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment in the 4th paragraph by striking out at the beginning of the first sentence, the following:

"A member" and inserting in its place the following: 'Except as otherwise provided by statute, a member'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 4th paragraph the following:

Further amend the bill in that part designated "<u>\$421.</u>" in subsection 3, by striking out at the beginning of the first sentence, the following: "<u>A member</u>" and inserting in its place the following: 'Except as otherwise provided by statute, a member'

Further amend the amendment by inserting before the last paragraph before the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill in the last paragraph before the statement of fact by striking out at the beginning of the first line the following: "Any" and inserting in its place the following: 'Except as otherwise provided by statute, any'

Statement of Fact

This amendment ensures that the provisions of the bill apply only when there is no specific statute to the contrary which applies to the agency.
