COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1212, L.D. 1442, Bill,

Amend the Bill in the 3rd line (2nd line in L.D.) after the
amending clause by striking out the underlined figure "150"
and inserting in its place the underlined figure '100'

Further amend the Bill in the 4th line (3rd line in L.D.)
after the amending clause by striking out the underlined
figure "150" and inserting in its place the underlined figure '100'

Statement of Fact

The amendment would reduce the number of ballots in each
lot from 150 to 100.
