IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Define the Term Intersection.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 1, sub-§ 3-D, is enacted to read:

3-D. Intersection. "Intersection" means the area embraced within the prolongation of the lateral curb lines or, if none, the lateral boundary lines of the traversable roadway or 2 or more roads or highways which join one another at an angle whether or not one road or highway crosses another.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would provide a definition of intersection in the motor vehicle laws. There is presently no definition in those laws although the word is used in a number of places in the laws.
