COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1221, L.D. 1448, Bill,
"AN ACT to Establish a Sign on the Maine Turnpike Showing
the Exit for Coastal Maine."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'23 MRSA §1201, sub-§29 is enacted to read:

29. Rockland area. Such sign shall be constructed
and maintained on the Maine Turnpike southerly of exit 9
and shall be worded as follows:

ROCKLAND AREA - EXITS 9 and 15'

on the Maine Turnpike directing motorists to the Rockland area.
