## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Establish a Sign on the Maine Turnpike Showing the Exit for Coastal Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

23 MRSA § 1201, sub-§ 29 is enacted to read:

29. Coastal Maine. This sign shall be constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike between miles 5 and 42 and shall be worded as follows: COASTAL MAINE RECREATIONAL AREA — CAMDEN, ROCKLAND, THOMASTON AND WARREN — EXITS 7, 9, 14 and 15.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for a sign between miles 5 and 42 on the Maine Turnpike alerting travelers that the coastal recreational area of Camden, Rockland, Thomaston and Warren can be reached by exiting at exits 7, 9, 14 or 15.
