AN ACT to Provide Retirement Credit to Charles J. Boetsch.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Charles J. Boetsch; increase in retirement benefits. The Maine State Retirement System shall grant a 6% increase in retirement benefits to Charles J. Boetsch of Rockport.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This bill grants a 6% increase in retirement benefits to Charles J. Boetsch of Rockport. In the First Special Session of the Legislature, increased retirement benefits were given to coastal wardens, fish and game wardens and state police officers who retired after July, 1976. Mr. Boetsch was one of 3 persons retiring in the period from January to June who missed this increase because he retired too soon, despite the fact that in all other respects he would have qualified for this increase. This bill will rectify this inequity.
