SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1217, L.D. 1453, Bill,  
"AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Provide Road and Bathing Facilities  
on Lucia Beach at Owls Head."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting  
in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Provide Road and Bathing Facilities at Birches Point  
Park at Owls Head.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after  
the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Road and bathing facilities at Birches Point Park authorized.  
The Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Recreation,  
shall construct and maintain a road and bathing facilities at  
Birches Point Park at Owls Head.'
