STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 108TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1175, L.D. 1455, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a State Gambling Commission and to Permit Gambling within Certain Areas of the State."

Amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all of subsections 7 and 9 of that part designated "<u>\$401.</u>" and by renumbering subsection 8 to be subsection 7.

Further amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the first paragraph of that part designated "<u>§403.</u>" and inserting in its place the following:

'The commission shall be under the immediate supervision and direction of a director, who shall be a person qualified by training and experience to oversee state gambling activities. The director shall be appointed by the Governor and shall serve in the unclassified service for a term coterminous with the Governor. He shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor, subject to removal for cause by the Governor. Any vacancy occuring shall be filled by appointment in the same manner as the original appointment for a like term.' Further amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all of paragraphs A and C of subsection 1 of that part designated "<u>\$406.</u>" and inserting in their place the following:

'A. Deal, operate, carry on, conduct, maintain or expose for play in the State any game or slot machine as defined in this chapter;

C. Receive, directly or indirectly, any compensation or reward or any percentage or share of the money or property COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1175, L.D. 1455

played, for keeping, running or carrying on any game or slot machine, without first having procured, and thereafter maintaining in full force and effect, all federal, state, county and municipal gambling licenses required by statute or ordinance.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes any provisions for off-track betting and changes the term of the director of the State Gambling Commission from 7 years to a term coterminous with the Governor and at his pleasure.
