# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT to Equalize the Property Tax on Watercraft.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA § 2070, sub-§ 7, 1st sentence, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 734, § 1, is amended to read:

Every certificate of number awarded under this chapter continues in force until December 31st of the 2nd complete calendar year after the year of issuance the 31st day of December next after its issuance.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA § 2070, sub-§ 11 is enacted to read:

11. Motorboat registration. No motorboat owner may register his boat pursuant to this chapter, unless he shall present to the official responsible for registration, receipts signed by a tax collector for all property tax payments on his boat since the last registration of his boat.

Sec. 3. 36 MRSA § 610-A is enacted to read :

§ 610-A. Motorboats

All motorboats taxed as personal property within the State shall, except as otherwise provided in this Title, be taxed at a rate of \$22 on each \$1,000 of the maker's list price according to books of value approved by the State Tax Assessor, regardless of the personal property tax rate of any municipality concerning the tax.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would provide a more uniform rate of property tax on motorboats. All motorboats would be taxed at a rate of \$22 per \$1,000 of value. Payment of all property taxes would be a prerequisite to obtaining registration for that boat.
