HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
H.P. 1230, L.D. 1475, Bill, "AN ACT to Expand the
Availability of Certain Social Services by Increasing Income
Eligibility."

Amend the Amendment in that part designated "§9."
in subsection 2 in paragraph A by striking out all of the
first underlined sentence and inserting in its place
the following:

'Any fees which are paid pursuant to this subsection
shall be paid to the agency which directly provides the
service; and, notwithstanding any provision in subsection 1
←----- these fees shall be used by the agency to
defray the expenses of services charged for and shall
proportionately reduce reimbursements to the agency by
the department for those services. ←-----> Funds generated
by the department as a result of the establishment of a
sliding fee scale shall be used for additional social services
of the type for which the fees have been paid.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that agencies
which provide day care services and other Title XX services
under contract with the Department of Human Services will
receive any fees collected under a sliding fee scale
established by the department.
