COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " To H.P. 1247, L.D. 1477, Bill, "AN ACT to Expedite the Construction of Natural Gas Pipelines in the State."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§2545" by striking out all of the third paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'Any natural gas pipeline company which makes application for site location of development approval pursuant to Title

38, section 481, et seq., shall, prior to filing a notification pursuant to Title 38, section 483, provide notice to each owner of real property upon whose land the applicant proposes to locate a natural gas pipeline by registered mail, postage prepaid at the land owner's last known address as contained in the applicable tax assessor's records and shall file with the town clerk of each municipality through which the pipeline is proposed to be located, a map demonstrating the intended approximate location of the pipeline within the municipality. The applicant shall not be required to provide notice of its intent to construct a natural gas pipeline other than as set forth in this paragraph.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1247, L.D. 1477 Page 2.

Nothing in this section shall excuse any natural gas

pipeline company or other entity from the requirement of

obtaining appropriate proprietary rights in State-owned land

prior to the construction or operation of any pipeline within
this State.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the language of the bill and requires that no construction or operation on state—owned lands shall take place without obtaining appropriate rights to the land.
