HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT/ to S.P. 423,
L.D. 1481, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing the Maine Student Incentive
Scholarship Program."

Amend the Amendment by striking out at the end of the 2nd
paragraph the semicolon and inserting in its place the following:
'Provided, however, that the death of a student's parents prior
to such graduation, or successful completion of a general education
development examination or its equivalent, shall not by itself operate
to disqualify an otherwise eligible student;'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment to the committee amendment is to
ensure that the death of parent prior to the completion of
a student's education does not exclude that student from financial
assistance.
