HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1260, L.D. 1489, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain Statutory Provisions for the Licensing of Camps, Eating and Lodging Places."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill by renumbering sections 2 through 6 to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

This amendment retains the present provision that people selling for consumption off premises don't have to be licensed by the Department of Human Services.
