SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1298, L.D. 1495, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing an Experimental Open Season on Moose."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§2355-E." by striking out all of subsection 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'3. District. There shall be one moose hunting district described as follows: All of Units 1, 2, 3 and 5 of the wildlife management units, excluding all of Baxter State Park.'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§2355-E." in subsection 4 by striking out all of the first sentence and inserting in its place the following:

'The Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife is authorized to issue not more than 600 moose hunting permits for Units 1, 2, 3 and 5 for the 1977 season.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment permits the experimental hunting of moose in Unit 3 as well as Units 1, 2 and 5.
