SENATE AMENDMENT " D " to H.P. 1298, L.D. 1495, Bill,
"AN ACT Establishing an Experimental Open Season on Moose."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§2355-E." in
subsection 4 by inserting after the 5th sentence the following:
'It shall also be required for an applicant to submit evidence
that he or she is a recipient of public assistance or eligible
for such assistance under state or federal law.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that harvesting of moose shall be
confined to those Maine residents most in need of nutrition.
