SENATE AMENDMENT "G" to H.P. 1298, L.D. 1495, Bill,  
"AN ACT Establishing an Experimental Open Season on Moose."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§2355-E." by striking out all of subsection 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'3. District. There shall be one moose hunting district described as follows: All of Units 1, 2 and 5 of the wildlife management units, excluding all of Baxter State Park and those townships adjacent to Baxter State Park.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides protection for those moose which inhabit Baxter State Park but do not observe the park boundaries.
