SENATE AMENDMENT "H " to H.P. 1298, L.D. 1495, Bill,  
"AN ACT Establishing an Experimental Open Season on Moose."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§2355-E." by  
inserting after subsection 14 the following:

'15. Public way limitation. No moose shall be slaughtered  
or killed within 150 feet from any public way or while swimming or  
wading in any great pond.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that a moose shall not be hunted  
in an unsportsmanlike manner or in such a manner as / <sup>to cause</sup> a hazard to  
public safety.
