SENATE AMENDMENT "H " to H.P. 1298, L.D. 1495, Bill,
"AN ACT Establishing an Experimental Open Season on Moose."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§2355-E." by inserting after subsection 14 the following:

'15. Public way limitation. No moose shall be slaughtered or killed within 150 feet from any public way or while swimming or wading in any great pond.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that a moose shall not be hunted to cause in an unsportsmanlike manner or in such a manner as / a hazard to public safety.
