SENATE AMENDMENT " I " to H.P. 1298, L.D. 1495, Bill,
"AN ACT Establishing an Experimental Open Season on Moose."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§2355-E." by
striking out all of subsection 6 and inserting in its place the
following:

'6. Weapons permitted. No implements other than cameras
shall be considered legal for hunting moose.'
