SENATE AMENDMENT "J" to H.P. 1298, L.D. 1495, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing an Experimental Open Season on Moose."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§2355-E." by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'1. Open season established. There shall be a controlled, open firearms season on bull moose for the year 1977 within the hunting district described in subsection 3.'

This amendment provides protection for those members of the herd capable of bearing young and not biologically mature.
