COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A to H.P. 1273, L.D. 1501, Resolve, to Authorize a Study of the Judicial Pension System of the State of Maine.

Amend the Resolve in the first paragraph by striking out the words: "Judicial Council of Maine" and inserting in their place the following: 'Board of Trustees of the State Retirement System'

Further amend the Resolve by striking out the 2nd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

Board of Trustees of the State Retirement System 'Resolved: That the is directed to complete such study by December 1, 1977, and to report on the results of such study, including recommendations for statutory changes or other measures for improvement, to the 2nd Regular Session of the 108th Legislature; and be it further'

Further amend the Resolve by striking out the 3rd and 4th paragraphs and inserting in their place the following:

Resolved: That the sume of \$5,000 is appropriated from the General Fund to the board of trustees to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this Amendment is to place the authority of the pension system study with the State Retirement System and to reduce the additional appropriation to \$5,000.
