COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1275, L.D. 1506, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish Dog Racing in the State of Maine."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "<u>§185.</u>" by striking out all of the 3rd underlined sentence and inserting in its place the following: '<u>The maximum</u> shall include the 6% tax prescribed in section 186.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all of that part designated "\$191."

Further amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all of that part designated "<u>§192."</u> and inserting in its place the following:

'§192. Conflicts of interest prohibited

Neither the State Dog Racing Commission nor any person, association or corporation conducting a racing establishment under the provisions of this chapter shall employ any person who has any pecuniary interest in dog racing.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 by renumbering those parts designated " $\underline{\$192}$. to $\underline{\$194}$." to be ' $\underline{\$191}$. to $\underline{\$193}$.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment corrects a misprint in the bill and deletes the 80% residency requirement for racing plant employees.
