L.D. 1515, Bill, "AN ACT to Reduce the Funding Level of the University
of Maine Law School, to Establish a Law School Loan Fund and to
Require Part-time Programs to be Offered at the University of
Maine Law School."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the next to the last paragraph before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'It is the intent of the Legislature that the University of Maine Law School offer extension programs for part-time students leading to a law degree.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the University of Maine Law School the sum of \$10,000 for the exclusive purpose of providing extension programs for part-time students. The breakdown shall be as follows:
