COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1263, L.D. 1515, Bill,
"AN ACT to Reduce the Funding Level of the University of Maine
Law School, to Establish a Law School Loan Fund and to Require
Part-time Programs to be Offered at the University of Maine
Law School."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting
in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Require Part-time Programs to be Offered at the
University of Maine Law School.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'CHAPTER 303-A

LEGAL EDUCATION

§2261. Extension programs

It is the intent of the Legislature that the University
of Maine Law School offer extension programs for part-time
students leading to a law degree and that the cost of any such
courses or programs be included in the law school budget and
be subsidized at the same rate as full-time students.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective
July 1, 1978.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove from the bill the provision to reduce the funding level of the University of Maine Law School and to establish a law school loan fund. the provision
