HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 445,
L.D. 1535, Bill, "AN ACT to Require Adequate Polling Facilities
in Municipalities."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the last 4 lines
before the statement of fact and inserting in their place the
following:

'at each voting place, except that, at the general election when
a President of the United States is elected, the municipal officers
in each municipality of 15,000 or more population shall provide
at least one voting booth for each 150 voters qualified to vote at
each voting place.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment would require one booth per 150 voters in
municipalities with a population of 15,000 or more only for the
presidential election, when more voters turn out.
